Alden Solovy spreads excitement for prayer. A Jewish poet and liturgist, he's written more than 550 pieces of new liturgy challenging the boundaries between prayer, meditation, personal growth and poetry. His work is widely anthologized and has been used by people of all faiths throughout the world. He's the author of *Jewish Prayers of Hope and Healing* and *Haggadah Companion: Meditations and Readings*. A native Chicagoan, Alden made aliyah to Israel in 2012 where he's an avid hiker, activist and leader in men's healing work. *The*


